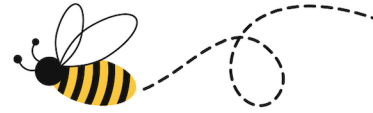
OUR POLLINATION QUIZ

POLLEN will get stuck to the bumblebees furry body when they visit flowers.

POLLINATION needs to happen for a flower to be able to transform into a fruit, to make seeds for more plants.



Bumblebees come out of hibernation around FEBRUARY and will be around for almost EIGHT months before they die or go back to sleep.
