Frequently Asked Questions

Q : What is a 'Spotlight Session' and how can I access it?

A : Having asked clients and teachers "how can we educate more children?" they recommended sessions that shone a spotlight on key curriculum topics and could be delivered electronically in the classroom - at a time suitable for teachers. Hence the Spotlight Sessions were born. Spotlight Sessions will be FREE to all our partner schools.

Q : What is the first Spotlight Session all about?

A : The first Spotlight Session is all about "Where Food Comes From". This session covers KS2 curriculum topics such as Pollination, Lifecycles, PSHE and Healthy Eating - in a brilliantly fun, educational way.

Q : What do I have to prepare?

A : Nothing! We provide **lesson plans, activity sheets and extension activities**. Simply print the resources appropriate to your year group. You will even have a 'Teacher's Copy' of the activities, which is a marked up version to support checking pupils work.

Q : Is the information linked to the curriculum?

A : The Spotlight Session is designed to cover **KS2 Science** and **PSHE curriculum themes**. Further details of the specific curriculum links are available in the lesson plans.

Q : How long is a Spotlight Session?

A : Each session is designed to last **45 minutes**, including activity run time. The session consists of three short videos to be shown in your classroom. The videos are broken up by activity sheets provided and directly link to the information the pupils have just learnt.

Q : Why do I need to share my email address and school name to download the resources?

A : This is simply so that we can let you know about future Spotlight Sessions and measure the impact of the initiative

Q : Will there be future Spotlight Sessions?

A : Absolutely! We're planning more Spotlight Sessions and expect to share one each school term with access to more resources that further develop pupils knowledge and relationship with nutrition and food.
