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HOW MANY BEES CAN YOU FIND ON THIS SHEET?













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1) What insect helps plants to fruit by pollinating them? BEES

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- 2) What do you call someone who looks after a garden? GARDENER
- 3) Bumblebees have smelly feet, which helps them not to REVISIT a flower.
- 4) What needs to happen for a flower to be able to transform into a fruit? (hint bumblebees really help with this) POLLINATION
- 5) Bumblebees help pollinate most types of BERRY, including strawberry, raspberry and blackberry.
- 6) Bumblebees prefer cooler WEATHER, as they will over-heat in hot conditions, which is why climate change is bad for bumblebees.
- 7) A green, bumblebee pollinated fruit (which you might think is a vegetable), which could be described as long and thin. CUCUMBER
- 8) A bumblebee pollinated, red fruit that grows on a vine or shrub. TOMATO
- 9) The buzz or hum bumblebees make could be described as a **BUMBLE**.
