CAN YOU COMPLETE OUR BUMBLEBEE QUIZ?



Bumblebees do not produce HONEY for us to eat.

Bumblebees will POLLINATE a flower when it is in the FLOWERING stage of its life cycle.

A bumblebee has four stages in its lifecycle: egg, larva, PUPA, and adult. After being laid, the eggs HATCH after four days and the queen feeds the larva on POLLEN and NECTAR.

A queen bumblebee will lay all the EGGS. And her WORKER bees will look after the nest, COLLECT food and raise new OFFSPRING.
